Under 16's Super League pushing for the NSW State Cup

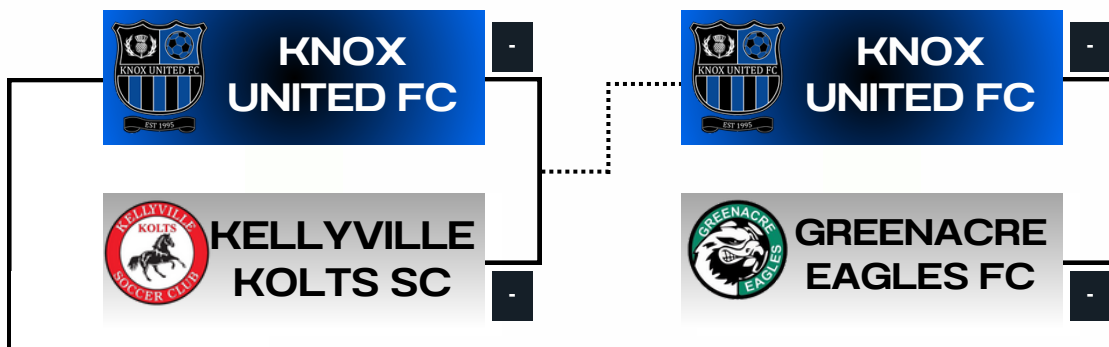

This season the team have been going up against teams that are an age group older than them in the regular NSFA season, proving games to be more challenging than normal. Alas, the U15's NSW State Cup is another competition the team have set their eyes on in 2025.

Narrowly being defeated by Lugarno FC in the 2024 Quarter Final, 0-0 at full time and going down 5-4 on penalties. The team are in good stead bounce back and exceed their 2024 run.
